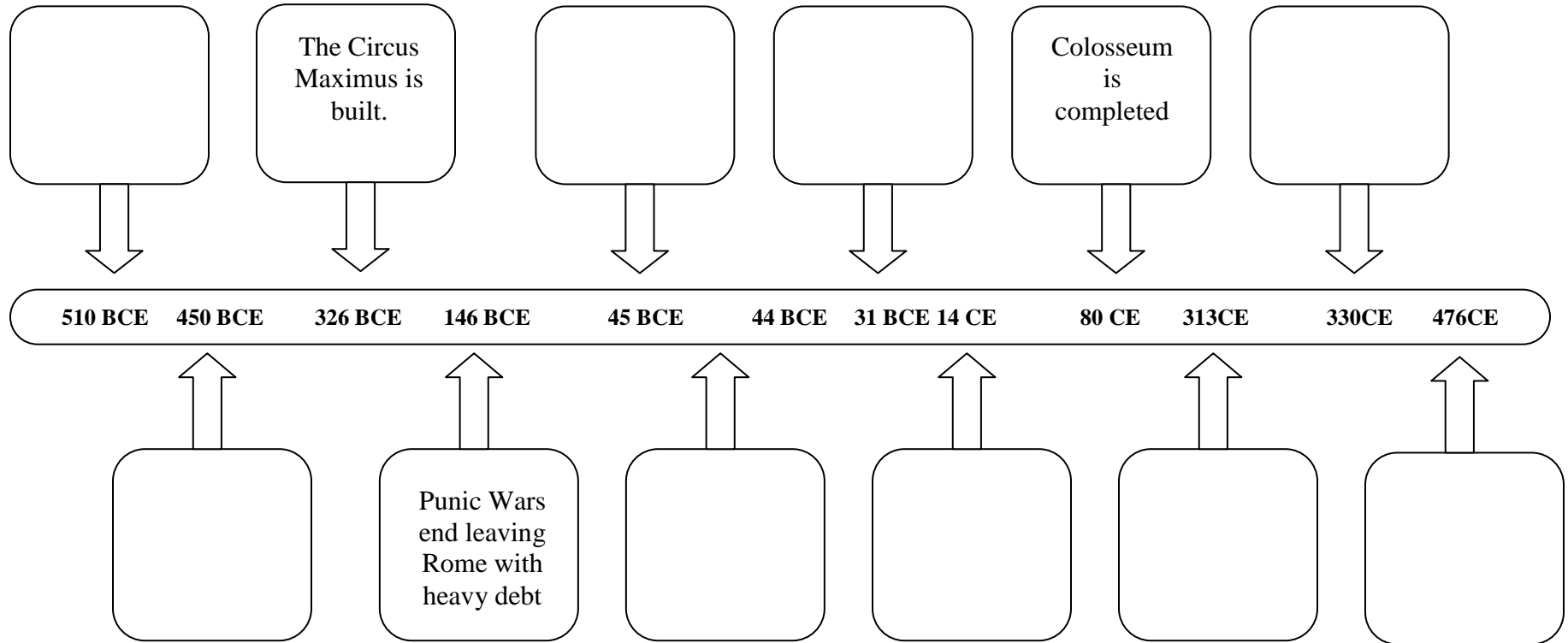


Use the above resources to fill in the most significant events of the Roman Empire. Some dates and events are already completed.
